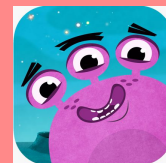

Blwyddyn 5/6 / Year 5/6

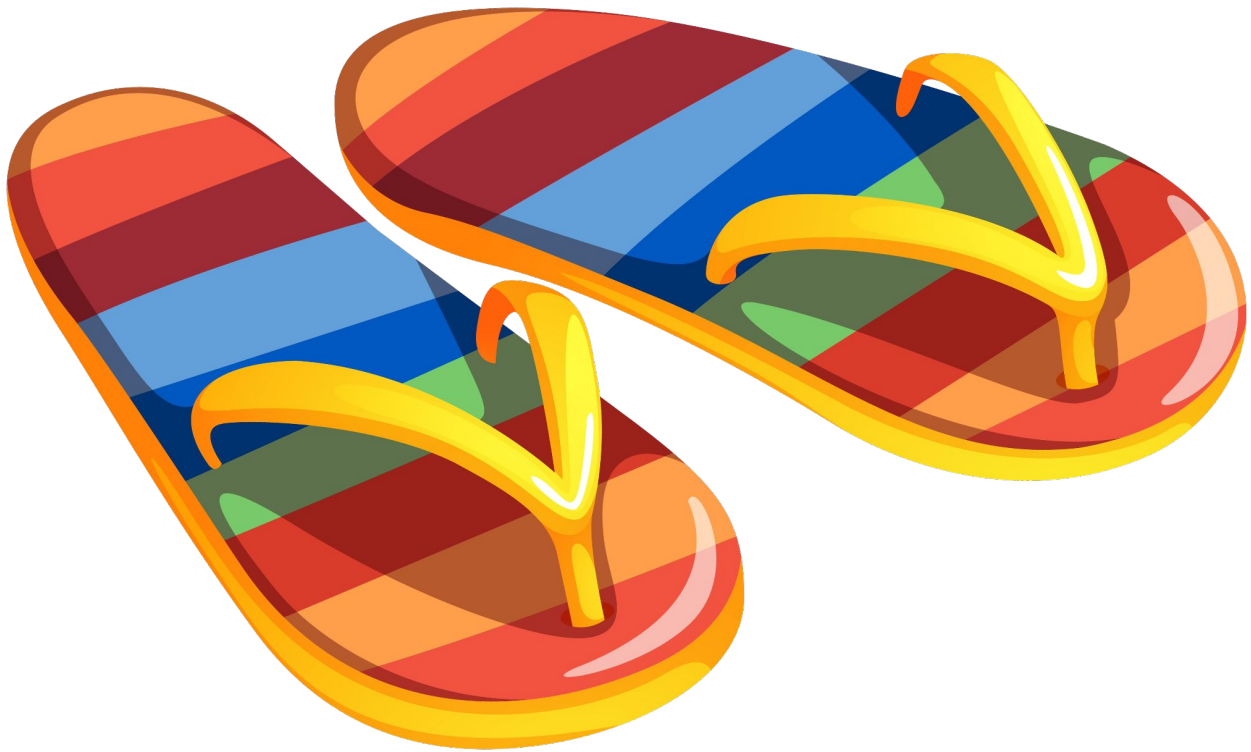
